HOW IT WORKS



Step 1: Families Are Nominated

Veteran and active duty families are nominated to receive Santa Boots gift packages.

Step 2: Gifts Are Donated

Patriotic families and businesses across the country curate gifts based on the families' interests and hobbies.

Step 3: Presents Are Wrapped

Approximately 15 to 20 personalized gifts are wrapped with love and packaged for delivery to each family.

Step 4: Boot Campaign Elves Deliver

Santa Boots gifts are hand-delivered just days before Christmas to military families in need.
